ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 78321 dated February 17, 1971, in Application No. 52359, American President Lines, Ltd., was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a common carrier by vessel between San Francisco and Los Angeles.

The carrier has submitted written notice that it is no longer engaged as a common carrier between San Francisco and Los Angeles.

On January 4, 1973, American President Lines, Ltd., abandoned service and ceased operations.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a common carrier by vessel between San Francisco and Los Angeles, authorized by Decision No. 78331 in Application No. 52359, is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of American President Lines, Ltd., are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this order to American President Lines, Ltd., at 601 California Street, San Francisco, CA 94108, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 30th day after the above mailing to American President Lines, Ltd., unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing, in which event, the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
