ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

A. R. Zacher Co., Inc., a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Fresno.

A. R. Zacher has informed the Commission by letter that the corporation is no longer involved in public warehousing and has not engaged in the public storage business for the last year. He requests that the operative right be revoked.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that revocation of the prescriptive operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked and that the tariff applicable to the services thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by A. R. Zacher Co., Inc., a corporation, as determined by the Commission's order dated August 1, 1960, in Case No. 6685, is hereby revoked.
- 2. A. R. Zacher Company, Inc. Warehouse Tariff Cal.P.U.C. No. 1 is hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon A. R. Zacher Co., Inc. or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
