ORDER EXTENDING PERIOD OF SUSPENSION

By an order of suspension and investigation, issued November 14, 1972, certain tariff sheets of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, filed under Advice Letter No. 10892, were suspended to and including March 16, 1973, pending public hearing and further order of the Commission. It appears that conclusion of the matter may not be accomplished by March 16, 1973, pending public hearing and further order of the Commission.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the operation and effectiveness of the tariff sheets filed under respondent's Advice Letter No. 10892 are hereby suspended, as provided by statute, for an additional period of six months to and including September 16, 1973, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.
