### SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 81079, dated February 23, 1973, in the above proceedings, among other things, reestablished expiration dates for temporary exception ratings in Sections 2-B and 2-C of Exception Ratings Tariff 1 which had been extended until further order of the Commission by Decision No. 79442 dated December 7, 1971, in conformity with the Federal Government's temporary freeze on rates. Since numerous petitions and an order setting hearing involving Sections 2-B and 2-C have heretofore been filed with the Commission and are now being considered, the action in Decision No. 81079 insofar as it relates to said sections is inappropriate and should be set aside pending disposition of the petitions and order setting hearing involved.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the necessary tariff corrections should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Exception Ratings Tariff I should be amended accordingly.

#### IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Exception Ratings Tariff 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective March 15, 1973, the supplement and revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which supplement, pages and appendix by this reference are made a part hereof.
- 2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decision No. 66195, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustment ordered herein.

- 3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the second day after the effective date of this order on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than March 15, 1973; tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the second day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.
- 4. Common Carriers, in establishing and maintaining the ratings authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the ratings published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects, Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
