ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 80350 in this proceeding granted Lemore Transportation, Inc. a certificate extension, with the customary requirement that service be instituted within one hundred twenty days after the effective date of the grant. Decision No. 80514 dismissed a petition for rehearing and established an effective date of September 19, 1972.

Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. has indicated that service was not instituted during the period specified because of problems in establishing certain railroad rates. It requests that Decision No. 80350 be re-established extending the time to comply with the various requirements of Decision No. 80350.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the time limit for compliance with the requirements of ordering paragraph 3(b) of Decision No. 80350 is extended to and including June 30, 1973.
