APDIlication of MOROSA BROS. TRANSPORIAIION CO., a California corporation, dba MOROSA BKOS. TRANSPORTATION AND IINN TRDCKING, to deviate from the rates as set forth in Minimu Rate Tariff No. 2 for transportation in pneumatic equipment for sand and crushed limestone, in bulk, for CONSOLIDATED) FIBERGLASS PRODUCTS, INC. Of Bakersfield, California, under the provilsions of Section 3666 of the Fublic Utilities Code.

## INTERIM ORINION ANE ORDER

Applicant condrets operations as a for-hire carrier pursuant to jighway contract carrier, radial higiway comon carrier, and dup truck carrier permits. It also bolds a cement carrier certificate. By this application it seeks authority to transport sand, NOI, from Interpace Company (Interpace) near Ione, California, and crusied or powdered limestone (lime rock) Erom Minnesota Mining and Manufacturing Company (3M CO.) near Corona, California, to Consoliciated Fiberglass Products, Incorporated (Consolidated) at Bakersfield, California, at rates less than the minimim zates set fort' in Minimun Rare Teriff 2. Toe transportation will be perfomed With pheumatic equipment winch is unloaded by air pressure in defiance of gravity.

Applicant states tbat the applicable minimum rate for tine transportation from Interpace is 57 cents per bundred pounds, minimum weight 40,000 pounds. Appifcant seeks authoxity to assess a rate of 48 cents per hundred pounds, minimum weight 50,000 pounds. Applicant also states that the applicable minimu rate for the transportation from 3M Co. is 42 cents per hundred pounds, winimu weizht

50,000 pounds. Applicant seeks authority to assess a rate of 34 cents, minimum weifht 50,000 pounds.

Applicant advences the following facts and circuastances 25 justification for the granting of the souzat relief. Consolidated is establishing a new plant at Bakersfield on or about March 15, 1973 to manufacture roofing materials and requires a continuous supply of the materials to keep its plant in operation. The presently applicable rates under Minimum Kate Tariff 2 are stated to be prohibizive from the consignee's cost standpoint. Consolidated estimates a need of 150 tons of sand and 200 tons of crushed limestone weekly.

Applicant anticipates revenues of $\$ 240.00$ per load of sand offset by expenses of $\$ 209.54$ resulting in a profit of $\$ 30.35$. it ancicipetes revenues of $\$ 170.00$ per $10 a d$ of crusbed 1 ifmestone offset by expenses of $\$ 152.93$ resulting in a profit of $\$ 17.02$.

The certificate of service shows that a copy of the application was mailed to California Irucking Association on February 7, 1573. The application was listed on the Comission's Daily Calendar of February 13, 1973. No oojection to the granting of the appincation has been rectived.

Subject to further review upon consideration of evidence which may be adduced at a pubinc hearing, it appears, and the Comission finds, tiat the rates'sought berein are reasonabie for the transportation to be performed by Morosa bros. Mransportation Co., doa Korosa Bros. Iransportation and Lynn Trucking. In view of the existing conditions, tie Comaission concludes that Morosa Bros. Transportation CO. should be granted interim authority to the extent bereinateer indscated for a period of six months. A future hearing will be scheduled in this proceeding.

2. The authority granted hexein shall expire six months after the effective date of this order.
3. A public bearing shall be scheduled in this proceeding for the receipt of evidence on this application.
