ORDER TERMINATING TEMPORARY
OPERATING AUTHORITY

On September 15, 1970, the Commission in Decision No. 77732 granted The Gray Line Tours Company a temporary certificate of public convenience and necessity to serve Lion Country Safari from various points in Southern California. On February 14, 1973, the Commission entered Decision No. 81036 in Applications Nos. 49177, 49980, and 50434. Decision No. 81036 has become final. It provides permanent authority similar to the temporary authority granted in Decision No. 77732. (D.81036, Attachment B, Items 15b, 100, 500.)

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the temporary certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to The Gray Line Tours Company in Decision No. 77732 is hereby terminated.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
