ORDER TERMINATING TEMPORARY
OPERATING AUTHORITY

On November 23, 1971, the Commission, in Decision No. 79415, granted The Gray Line Tours Company a temporary certificate of public convenience and necessity to include the Queen Mary in its Lion Country Safari tour. On February 14, 1973, the Commission entered Decision No. 81036 in Applications Nos. 49177, 49980, and 50434. Decision No. 81036 has become final. It provides for permanent authority similar to the temporary authority granted in Decision No. 79415. (Decision No. 81036, Attachment B, Item 500.)

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the temporary certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to The Gray Line Tours Company in Decision No. 79415 is hereby terminated.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
