ORDER DISCONTINUING INVESTIGATION

Decision No. 76527 found that The Gray Line Tours Company was not operating its Tour No. 1005 as authorized by the Commission. This investigation was commenced at the time Decision No. 76527 was filed. The investigation has been held in abeyance because of the pendency of Applications Nos. 49177, 49980, and 50434, which, in part, sought a restatement of Gray Line's operating rights. The question of Tour No. 1005 was considered in Decision No. 81036 in Applications Nos. 49177, 49980, and 50434. (Decision No. 81036, Attachment A, p. 37, fn. 14.) Decision No. 81036 restated Gray Line's operating rights in the light of Decision No. 76527. (Attachment B, Appendix A, Item 15a.) Decision No. 81036 has become final. In the circumstances there is no longer any need for this investigation.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the investigation on the Commission's own motion in Case No. 9002 is hereby discontinued.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
