SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

American Pacific Stage Company, a corporation, is a passenger stage corporation operating under a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by this Commission. By Decision No. 80663 dated October 31, 1972, in Application No. 47391, Union Pacific Stage Company changed its corporate name to American Pacific Stage Company. In letters dated November 17, 1972, and December 27, 1972, the carrier requested correction of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to reflect the fact that the rail passenger service previously operated by the Union Pacific Railroad Company is presently conducted by the National Railroad Passenger Corporation (AMTRAK). In addition, the carrier states that the East Los Angeles Station of the Union Pacific Railroad Company is not being served by American Pacific Stage Company and, therefore, should be deleted from its certificate.

Pursuant to the foregoing developments, the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued to American Pacific Stage Company should be amended.

IT IS ORDERED that:

The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to American Pacific Stage Company is hereby amended as set forth in attached Appendix A.

SECTION 1: General Authorizations, Restrictions,
Limitations and Specifications.

American Pacific Stage Company, a corporation, is authorized to transport passengers and their baggage between*Los Angeles Union Passenger Terminal, on the one hand, and Pasadena, Anaheim, Orange and Long Beach, on the other hand, over and along the routes hereinafter described, subject, however, to the authority of this Commission to change or modify said routes at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- (a) When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operation in either direction, unless otherwise indicated.
- (b) Motor vehicles may be turned at termini or intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets, or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections, in accordance with local traffic regulations.
- (c) When service is rendered on an "on-call" basis, tariffs and timetables of American Pacific Stage Company shall show the conditions under which the "on-call" service will be rendered.

- (d) Applicant is permitted to handle only such passengers whose origin or destination is at the Los Angeles Union Passenger Terminal or points beyond said stations via the *National Railroad Passenger Corporation (AMTRAK) and the handling of such passengers is permitted only on motor coaches operating as a connecting service for *National Railroad Passenger Corporation (AMTRAK) passenger trains serving said Los Angeles Union Passenger Terminal.

SECTION 2: Route Descriptions

Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify such at any time, American Pacific Stage Company shall conduct its passenger stage operations between the following points and over and along the following routes:

Route 1 - *Los Angeles to Long Beach

Commencing at *Los Angeles Union Passenger Terminal, then via the most direct or appropriate route or routes through the cities of Maywood, Bell, South Gate, Lynwood, Paramount, Lakewood, and Long Beach to the *AMTRAK City Office in Long Beach.

Route 2 - *Los Angeles to Pasadena

Commencing at *Los Angeles Union Passenger Terminal, thence via the most direct or appropriate route or routes through the Cities of Monterey Park, Alhambra, South Pasadena, San Marino and Pasadena, to the *AMTRAK Office in Pasadena.
