SECOND ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By letter dated March 5, 1973, the San Diego Economy Line, Inc., requests an additional one-year extension of time in which to restore service to its Route No. 1 (San Diego-Homeland) because of continuing financial difficulties.

The Commission authorized the San Diego Economy Line, Inc., to suspend operations on its Route No. 1 (San Diego-Homeland) until April 1, 1972 by Decision No. 78684 in Application No. 47958. This authority was extended until April 1, 1973 by Decision No. 79861 dated March 28, 1972.

Applicant is currently operating Route No. 2 (College Grove-San Ysidro) six days a week and does not desire to abandon Route No. 1. Applicant believes current negotiations for a county subsidy now pending may materially aid in restoration of its Route No. 1.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that San Diego Economy Line, Inc., is granted an extension of time in which to restore service to its Route No. 1 (San Diego-Homeland) to April 1, 1974.
