SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 74082 dated May 7, 1968, as amended by Decisions Nos. 74541 and 75682 dated August 13, 1968, and May 20, 1969, the Commission amended the certificates of various highway common carriers of general commodities by excluding therefrom the transportation of trailer coaches and campers when such transportation was not provided as evidenced by the tariffs on file with the Commission.

Boland Trucking Co., Inc. (Boland), does not have tariffs on file with the Commission naming rates for the transportation of trailer coaches and campers, but its certificate is not presently so restricted. In investigating this matter, the Commission staff was informed by Boland that it has not transported said commodities in the past and does not intend to transport them in the future as it is not equipped to do so. Boland has requested that the aforementioned commodities be excluded from its certificate.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that amendment of the certificate, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the carrier's certificate should be amended accordingly.





IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision No. 79840 is amended by incorporating therein First Revised Page 3, attached hereto, in revision of Original Page 3.

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Boland Trucking Co., Inc., shall amend its tariffs on file with the Commission covering its common carrier operations described in Decision No. 79840 to indicate that the rates in such tariffs do not apply to the transportation of trailer coaches and campers, including integral parts and contents when the contents are within the trailer coach or camper.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

3. Through routes and rates may be established between any and all points specified in paragraphs 1 and 2 above.
4. All intermediate points on said routes and all off-route points within the outer perimeters of the routes designated herein may be served.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

1. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in Item 5 of Minimum Rate Tariff 4-B;
2. Livestock, viz.: barrows, boars, bulls, butcher hogs, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, feeder pigs, gilts, goats, heifers, hogs, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, rams (bucks), sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags, swine, or wethers;
3. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semiplastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles;
4. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper type trucks;
5. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit;
6. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerator equipment;
7. Articles of extraordinary value as set forth in Item 780 of National Motor Freight Classification A-12, William Herbold, Issuing Officer, or the issue date hereof;
8. Fresh fruits and vegetables;
9. Trailer coaches and campers, including integral parts and contents when the contents are within the trailer coach or camper.
