ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 80378 dated August 15, 1972, Virgil H. Monnet and Geneva C. Monnet, doing business as Manufacturers Distribution Terminal, were granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a public utility warehouseman in 25,000 square feet of space in the city of Emeryville. By Decision No. 80949 dated January 1, 1973, the time for commencing operations was extended to April 15, 1973. Because of certain internal reorganizational problems, it is requested that the time within which to commence operations be extended to June 15, 1973.

IT IS ORDERED that the time to commence operations pursuant to the provisions of Decision No. 80378 is hereby extended to June 15, 1973.
