OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 81012 the Commission ordered that the application be denied unless applicant or an employee passed an examination covering the Commission Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-B on or before March 1, 1973. The order further provided that in the event an examination was not passed, the household goods carrier permit held by Ferne L. Brown as surviving spouse of Fred L. Guthrie be immediately placed in suspension and revoked sixty days thereafter, unless an application is filed to transfer the permit.

Ferne L. Brown subsequently requested cancellation of the scheduled examination and revocation of the household goods carrier permit held by her as surviving spouse of Fred L. Guthrie, because of termination of the business.

Good cause appearing, it is ordered that:

1. The application of Ferne L. Brown, surviving spouse of Fred L. Guthrie, to transfer a household goods carrier permit to Tiger Moving & Storage, Inc., is hereby denied.
2. The household goods carrier permit held by Ferne L. Brown as surviving spouse of Fred L. Guthrie is hereby revoked.
