1. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective April 28, 1973, the supplement and revised pages contained in Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications resulting in increases authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the first day after the effective date of this order, on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public; such authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within sixty days after the effective date of this order; and tariff publications resulting in reductions may be made effective not earlier than the first day after the effective date of this

order, and may be made effective on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

3. In all other respects, Decisions Nos. 31606 and 80771, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
