SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 69469 dated July 27, 1965, in the above proceedings, Directory 1 was established to provide for descriptions of production areas and delivery zones and rules governing such descriptions applicable in connection with Minimum Rate Tariff 17 for the transportation of rock, sand and gravel in southern California. It has come to the Commission's attention that Orange County Delivery Zones 30102 and 30103, as presently described in Directory 1, need to be amended. The present common boundary between the two zones was established when the area was relatively uninhabited and undeveloped. Since then considerable construction activity and development have occurred in the area. As a result thereof, determination of the precise common boundary between the aforementioned zones has become uncertain.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the involved zone boundary should be clarified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Directory 1 should be amended to reflect current metes and bounds for Delivery Zones 30102 and 30103 by the order herein.

IT IS ORDERED that:
