ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This complaint was filed on February 2, 1972 and the answer on March 10, 1972. It was scheduled for hearing on September 27 and 28, 1972 in Los Angeles, after the parties could not agree on an earlier date. During the September 27 hearing, counsel for complainants requested that the matter be continued to a date to be It was later placed on the December 5, 6, and 7 Daily Calendar in los Angeles. On December 5, 1972, counsel for the complainants telephoned the Los Angeles office of the Commission to ask that the complaint in Case No. 9322 be removed from the Commission's Daily Calendar. The Commission's Secretary advised the parties and counsel by letter dated January 3, 1973 that the complaint would be dismissed unless scheduled for hearing within 45 days. A second letter was mailed to the parties on February 22, 1973 to advise that the complaint in Case No. 9322 would be dismissed unless rescheduled for hearing. No replies have been received, and there has been no request to place Case No. 9322 back on the Commission's Daily Calendar.

The Commission, therefore, concludes that the complaint should be dismissed for want of prosecution.

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint in Case No. 9322 is dismissed.
