SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Jack Thompson Trucking, Inc., holds certificates of public convenience and necessity to operate as a cement carrier and a highway common carrier.

The cement carrier authority was created by Resolution No. 13825, dated June 23, 1964, under a "grandfather" right. It acquired the highway common carrier authority of Special Services Transportation Corporation, Ltd., pursuant to Decision No. 80002, dated May 2, 1972, as amended, in the above proceeding.

Documents have been filed showing that Jack Thompson Trucking, Inc., is a wholly owned subsidiary of Thompson Transport Systems, Inc., a California corporation (formerly called Thompson Properties, Inc.), and that the subsidiary corporation has elected to wind up and dissolve. All of the assets and liabilities of Jack Thompson Trucking, Inc. are being transferred to and assumed by Thompson Transport Systems, Inc.

The Commission has been requested to transfer the operating authorities to the parent corporation.

After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed transfer would not be adverse to the public interest and should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Jack Thompson Trucking, Inc. may transfer and Thompson Transport Systems, Inc. may acquire the operative rights granted by Resolution No. 13825, dated June 23, 1964 and Decision No. 80002, dated May 2, 1972 as amended by Decision No. 80326, dated August 1, 1972, in Application No. 53123.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. Resolution No. 13825, dated June 23, 1964 is hereby amended, and Decision No. 80002, dated May 2, 1972, as amended by Decision No. 80326, dated August 1, 1972, in Application No. 53123, is hereby further amended by substituting the name "Thompson Transport Systems, Inc." in place and stead of "Jack Thompson Trucking, Inc."

2. Within one hundred and twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than 10 days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Thompson Transport Systems, Inc., a corporation, shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rules Nos. 6.1 of General Order No. 80-A and 6.1 of General Order No. 117, as applicable.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
