Application of the State of California Department of Public Works for an order authorizing construction of four new crossings at separated grades whereby Routes 5 and 210 and county road traffic will be carried over tracks of Southern Pacific Company, referred to as WEST SYLMAR OVERHEAD, BALBOA BOULEVARD OVERCROSSING, ROUTE 210/5 SEPARATION AND OVERHEAD and SAN FERNANDO ROAD OVERHEAD, and the alteration of an existing overhead (previously known as "Route 210/5 Separation and Overhead"), in the City of Los Angeles.

Application of the State of California, Department of Public Works, for an emergency order, due to the demolition of State Highway facilities in the Sylmar Area in the City of Los Angeles occasioned by an earthquake February 9, 1971, authorizing the construction of a temporary crossing at separated grades over the mainline tracks of Southern Pacific Transportation Company and San Fernando Road, hereinafter referred to as San Fernando Road Overhead (Detour).

Application of the State of California Department of Public Works for an order authorizing construction of two crossings at separated grades and widening of one existing grade separation over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company, in connection with the construction of an interchange between Routes 5 and 14, in the County of Los Angeles, referred to as "Route 14/5 Separation and Overhead", Bridge No. 53-1960 R; "South Connector Overcrossing", Bridge No. 53-1963; and "Weldon Canyon Overhead", Bridge No. 53-849.

ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant has requested an extension of time within which to exercise the authority granted in Decisions 73830, 78359 and 75165, respectively, alleging that the projects were damaged by an earthquake and necessitated removal prior to the completion thereof. It is anticipated that the projects will be completed by January 26, 1976.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted in said decisions is hereby extended to January 26, 1976.

In all other respects Decisions 73830, 78359 and 75165 shall remain in full force and effect. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
