ORDER VACATING SUSPENSION
AND INVESTIGATION ORDER

On February 14, 1973 the following tariff sheets of
General Telephone Company of California, filed on January 22, 1973
under Advice Letter No. 2890, were suspended through June 23, 1973--

Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. L-1
(Mobile Telephone Service)

29th Revised Check Sheet A
6th Revised Sheet 5

These tariff sheets provide for a one-way personal
signaling service in the Thousand Oaks Exchange and were
suspended pending investigation upon receipt of a joint protest
from Industrial Communication Systems, Inc. and Intrastate Radio-
telephone, Inc. of Los Angeles alleging that the proposed service
would economically interfere with and injure the operation of
their paging systems.

In accordance with a stipulation made March 27, 1973,
herein received as Exhibit 1, protestants withdraw their joint
protest to respondent's Advice Letter No. 2890 and related
tariff sheets and request dismissal of Case No. 9509 with the
agreement that such action is without prejudice to the issues
and positions of respondent, protestants, and Pacific Telephone
and Telegraph Company in Cases Nos. 9395, 9396, and 9397 before

this Commission and cannot be construed to preclude protestants from lawfully providing one-way paging service in Thousand Oaks Exchange area. It is further agreed that respondent's proposed personal signaling service in the Thousand Oaks Exchange will not constitute a part of its one-way paging system in the Los Angeles Extended Area.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The suspension order of February 14, 1973 is vacated and set aside.
2. This proceeding is discontinued.
3. The aforesaid tariff sheets are to become effective as of the date of this order.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
