ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 80225

By letter dated May 1, 1973 respondent carrier's attorney advised the Commission that his client had not paid amounts due ten of the 42 subhaulers he was directed to pay by Decision No. 80225 dated July 11, 1972. The other 32 have been paid. The letter states that eight of the unpaid subhaulers cannot be located, one owes respondent carrier more than is owed to it, and one has refused to accept payment. The Commission staff has reviewed the matter and has recommended that respondent carrier should be relieved from further obligation to comply with Ordering Paragraphs 4 and 5 of Decision No. 80225 which require payments to subhaulers and reports in connection therewith, respectively. We concur.

IT IS ORDERED that Phillip Aboumrad, doing business as Phil's Trucking & Produce Service, is relieved from further obligation to comply with Ordering Paragraphs 4 and 5 of Decision No. 80225.

in full force and effect.
