ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 80814 dated December 12, 1972 granted interim authority to applicant to assess rates five cents per 100 pounds less than the minimum rates for the transportation of sugar in packages, on shipments weighing 10,000 pounds or more, for Spreckels Sugar Division, Amstar Corporation, from Spreckels to points in California and to return empty pallets to the shipper without charge. The authority is subject to certain conditions and will expire June 12, 1973. The decision provided that the application would be set for public hearing for the receipt of evidence prior to the expiration date.

Public hearing was held on May 17, 1973. Further hearing is scheduled for June 11, 1973. In order to avoid any lapse of the interim authority prior to the issuance of a final decision, applicant has requested that it be extended for an additional three months. There were no objections to the requested extension. It will be granted.

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IT IS ORDERED that the expiration date of the interim authority granted to Trans-Valley Transport, Inc. by Decision No. 80814 is extended to September 12, 1973.
