## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Decision No. 80699 dated November 8, 1972 granted interim authority to Donald Cowan, doing business as Cowan Trucking Co\%, and to James E. Corey, doing business as Corey Trucking Company, to deviate from the minimum rates set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff 17, by assessing a rate of $\$ 17.00$ per hour, but not less than the applicable minimu hourly rate set forth in Minimum Rate Tarife 7 subject to the rules and regulations in that tariff, for the transportation of pit-run unprocessed sand and gravel for Nelson \& Sloan from its Birch PIt (Production Area 37 NN) to its. Main Plant, located at Broadway and Main Streets in Otay (Delivery Zone 37925).

The interim authority was scheduled to expire six months after the date of Decision No. 80699. Applicants have 1nformed the Comission that they no longer desire to perform the transportation service at less than minimum rates.

To clear the Comission's records the application herein should be dismissed.

Therefore, II IS ORDERED that Application No. 53128, filed by Donald W. Cowan and James E. Corey, is dismissed. The effective date of this order is the date hereof. Dated at Sad Francisco , California, this 19 th day of $\qquad$ , 1973.
