ORDER EXTENDING EXPIRATION DATE

By interim order in Decision No. 80996 applicants were authorized to charge less than the established minimum rates for the transportation of empty glassware bottles between certain points at railhead. That authority is scheduled to expire July 1, 1973 unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended. Public hearings have been held in these applications on May 29 and 30, 1973. It appears doubtful that a final decision in these proceedings can be made effective prior to the expiration date of the interim authority. The greatest volume of movement of empty bottles occurs during the summer months because of the canning season;

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the expiration date of July 1, 1973 of the authority granted in Decision No. 80996 is extended until further order herein.
