SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 80994 dated January 30, 1973 in the aboveentitled matter found that Claude R. Snead (Snead) transported 124
shipments of lumber for L. S. Jones Timber Products Corp. (Jones) at
rates less than the minimum rates resulting in undercharges totaling
\$6,299.49. The decision ordered respondent to pay a fine of
\$6,799.49 (\$6,299.49 pursuant to Section 3800 and \$500 pursuant
to Section 3774 of the Public Utilities Code). The entire fine was
to be paid by March 13, 1973. On March 13, 1973 Snead paid \$500.
By letter dated May 18, 1973 Snead's attorney advised that Snead
is not financially able to pay the remaining \$6,299.49 until after
Snead collects from Jones. The letter also advised that suit has
been filed against Jones for the undercharges totaling \$6,299.49.

The Commission finds and concludes that Snead should pay the balance of the fine in the manner set forth in the ensuing order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Respondent Claude R. Snead shall pay the balance of the fine (\$6,299.49) ordered by Decision No. 80994 in the following manner:

Respondent Claude R. Snead shall notify the Commission in writing within five days after the collection of any undercharges from respondent L. S. Jones Timber Products Corp. The notification shall specify the amount collected, and said amount shall be remitted by respondent in full or partial payment of the remainder of the fine imposed by Decision No. 80994.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 80994 shall remain in full force and effect.
