O P I N I O N

By this application Chipman Van & Storage, Inc. seeks authority to suspend operations of 3,000 square feet of public utility warehouse space in Napa, California.

Applicant alleges that it has lost its lease on the property in which it conducted operations and its tenancy expired March 31, 1973. Applicant anticipates that a number of months may be required for it to find suitable space in which to resume operations in Napa. Applicant therefore requests authorization to suspend its operations in Napa for a period of two years.

There are no protests.

After consideration, the Commission finds that the public interest will not be adversely affected if applicant's request is granted and concludes that it should be authorized to suspend its warehouseman operations at Napa.

A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Applicant's operating authority as a public utility warehouseman in Napa is suspended for a period of two years from the effective date of this order.

2. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend its tariffs presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
