ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Edward H. Artman possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at San Luis Obispo.

Edward H. Artman has not filed with the Commission any annual reports since 1965. Moreover, Commission records indicate that mail addressed to Edward H. Artman at his last known address has been returned by the Post Office marked "Addressee Unknown."

Edward H. Artman not having filed the annual reports as required by Section 584 of the Public Utilities Code and apparently no longer operating as a public utility warehouseman, the Commission finds that such circumstances constitute good cause for revocation of the operative right and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the services thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Edward H. Artman as determined by the Commission's order dated August 9, 1960, in Case No. 6749 is hereby revoked.
- 2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of Edward H. Artman, doing business as Artman Van & Storage Co., from California Warehouse Tariff Burcau Warehouse Tariff No. 34, Cal.P.U.C. No. 181, on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

Case No. 6749 - JW The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Edward H. Artman or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.
