SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Pasha Warehouses, Inc., a corporation, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at San Francisco.

Pasha Warehouses, Inc. has submitted to this Commission a copy of its Certificate of Amendment of Articles of Incorporation, certified by the Secretary of State, indicating that its corporate name has been changed to American Cold Storage Company, Inc. Accordingly its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name and the warehouseman will be ordered to amend its tariffs on file with the Commission pursuant to General Order No. 61-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Pasha Warehouses, Inc., a corporation, by Decision No. 71744 dated December 29, 1966, in Application No. 48949, is amended by substituting therein "American Cold Storage Company, Inc." in place and stead of "Pasha Warehouses, Inc."


2. Appendix A of Decision No. 71744 is amended by incorporating therein First Revised Page 1, attached hereto, in revision of Original Page 1.


3. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, American Cold Storage Company, Inc. shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule 6.2 of General Order No. 61-A.


The Secretary is directed to mail a copy of this order to American Cold Storage Company, Inc. and to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.


This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
