## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 81125 dated March 13, 1973 authorized Walter F. Peters to sell and transfer his certiricates of priblic convenience and necessity as a highway common carrier and cement carrier and a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman to Peters Truck Ifnes, a corporation, on or before June 30, 2973.

By letter dated July 3, 1973 applicants request that the time to accompilsh the transfer be extended to September 30, 1973 since the transfer of interstate authority has not yet been seoomplished and applicants desire to concurrently consumate the transfer of the interstate and intrastate authorities.

IT IS ORDERED thet:

1. Paragraphs 1 and 2 of the order in Decision No. 81125 are amended as follews:
2. On on before September 30, 1973, Walter F. Peters may sell and trangfer, and Peters Truck Innes may purchase and acquire, the highway common carrier and cement carrier certiilcates of public convenience and necessity, the prescriptive operative right as a public utility warenouseman, and the reiated assets referred to in the application.
3. Peters Truck Lines, on or after the effective date hereof, and on or before September 30 , 1573, may issue not exceeding 250,000 shares of its $\$ 2.00$ par value common stock. 2. In all other respects Decision No. 81125 shall remain in
full force and effect.
