ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 81434

Decision No. 81434 dated May 30, 1973 in Application No. 53899 granted applicants authority to charge rates which differ from the minimum rates for the transportation of welding equipment and supplies for Moore's Welding Supply Company between the shipper's locations in Chico and Sacramento for a one-year period to expire May 30, 1974. The authorization provides, among other things, that articles to be transported need not be itemized on the shipping documents.

By letter dated June 15, 1973, the California Trucking Association has advised the Commission that welding supplies typically include compressed gas in cylinders and that other statutory provisions preclude carriers from accepting this and other hazardous materials for transportation unless they are described on the shipping document. In order to avoid any confusion in this regard, the authority will be amended to specifically provide that any dangerous articles shall be listed on the shipping documents as required by Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations and/or Dangerous Articles Tariff 15, Cal. P.U.C. 10, American Trucking Association, Agent.
