C. 9395, 9551, 9552 af ORDER EXTENDING PERIODS OF SUSPENSION Ordering Paragraph 2 in the Order of Suspension and Investigation in Case No. 9551 provides that the operation and effectiveness of the tariffs filed by General Telephone Company of California under Advice Letter No. 2939 are suspended to and including September 3, 1973, unless otherwise ordered. Ordering Paragraph 2 in the Order of Suspension in Case No. 9552 similarly provides that the operation and effectiveness of the tariffs filed by The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company under Advice Letter No. 11039 are suspended to and including September 3, 1973, unless otherwise ordered. Further public hearing having been set in Cases Nos. 9552 and 9551 for July 16-20, 1973, it appears that a Commission decision in these proceedings cannot become effective prior to September 3, 1973, and that the period of suspension of the effective date of the tariffs should be extended. Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the suspensions of the effective date of the tariffs filed by Advice Letter No. 11039 of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company and by Advice Letter No. 2939 of General Telephone Company of California be, and they hereby are, extended for further periods of six months beyond September 3, 1973, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.
