SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff 2 names minimum rates for the state-wide transportation of general commodities by highway carriers including specific rates for the transportation of paper and paper articles within the Metropolitan Los Angeles Area.

It has come to the Commission's attention that an inadvertent change in the punctuation of the commodity description on paper and paper articles in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 has made the application of the rates on such commodities uncertain.¹

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the aforementioned commodity description should be clarified by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Minimum Rate Tariff 2 should be amended accordingly.

¹The commodity description is set forth in detail in Item 770 of the tariff.

IS IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D of Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective August 16, 1973, Fourth Revised Page 66-L, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.


2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than August 16, 1973.


3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendment authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendment published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.


4. In all other respects Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.


The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
