ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION
AND REVOKING CERTIFICATE
OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE
AND NECESSITY

By letter dated June 18, 1973 from applicant Linas T. Redman to the Commission filed June 20, 1973, the applicant requests that Application No. 53833 be dismissed. He also states:

"I further wish to abandon the rights and existing certificate of convenience and necessity issued pursuant to Decision No. 43167 acquired in Decision No. 62775, dated November 6, 1961.

"There is no longer adequate passenger revenue to warrant the continued operation of our vehicle or a passenger stage, as such, between the city of Bakersfield and the Kern County Airport at Meadows Field."

The Commission staff has recommended that Application No. 53833 be denied and that the relatively unused certificate authority be revoked.

After consideration the Commission finds:

1. The application herein should be dismissed.
2. Public convenience and necessity no longer require a continuation of applicant's service.
3. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The application is dismissed.
2. On August 31, 1973, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, Linas T. Redman may discontinue his passenger stage service.
3. All tariffs and timetables presently on file with this Commission in applicant's name are cancelled.
4. The operative rights authorized by Decision No. 62775 in Application No. 43791 are revoked.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
