ORDER

Decision No. 80744, issued November 21, 1972, concluded that rice drying, performed in conjunction with the storage of rice in warehousing operations, is a public utility service. Ordering Paragraph 1 in that decision directed applicants to file tariffs naming rates for the drying of paddy rice.

On March 23, 1973 applicants filed a petition for writ of review with the California Supreme Court (S.F. No. 23000). Thereafter, applicants petitioned the Commission to suspend the tariff filing requirement mentioned above until such time as the Supreme Court has acted on the petition for review.

On April 10, 1973 the Commission issued Decision No. 81269 suspending Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 80744 "... until further order of the Commission." On July 12, 1973 the Supreme Court denied applicants' petition for review.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that applicants in Application No. 52547 that participate in Item 80 (Paddy Rice in Bulk) of California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Tariff No. 38, Cal.P.U.C. No. 203 of Jack L. Dawson, Agent, are directed to file a tariff or tariffs

with this Commission naming rates for the drying of paddy rice. Said tariff or tariffs shall be filed on or before ninety days after the effective date of this order and shall become effective on thirty days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
