SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 81149 in Application No. 53835 and Decision
No. 81175 in Application No. 53836, Morosa Bros. Transportation Co.
(Morosa) was granted interim authority to depart from the minimum
rates for certain transportation performed for Consolidated Fiberglass
Products, Inc. (Consolidated). The interim authorities are scheduled
to expire September 13, 1973 and September 20, 1973.

By letter dated July 10, 1973 Morosa has requested that the expiration dates of Decisions Nos. 81149 and 81175 be extended for six months or until further order of the Commission. The letter states that Consolidated has informed Morosa that, because of delays in equipment deliveries and construction, full operations are now expected to commence September 30, 1973, rather than July 1, 1973 as originally projected.

In the circumstances it appears and the Commission finds that the expiration dates of Decisions Nos. 81149 and 81175 should be extended to March 15, 1974.

IT IS ORDERED that the expiration dates of the interim authorities granted by Decisions Nos. 81149 and 81175 are extended to March 15, 1974.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
