## <u>OPINION</u>

Laverne J. Heenan, doing business as Live Oak Warehouses and Farm Supply, requests authority to discontinue operations as a public utility werehouseman in the vicinity of Live Oak.

The certificate was granted by Decision No. 67914 dated September 30, 1964 in Application No. 46759 and authorizes operations in 25,050 square feet of storage space.

It is alleged that the property has been leased to private concerns and all public storage has been discontinued.

After consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's service as a public utility warehouseman. The certificate will be revoked. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 67914 dated September 30, 1964 in Application No. 46759 is revoked and Werehouse Tariff No. 2 on file with this Commission in the name of Laverne J. Reenan, doing business as Live Oak Warehouses and Farm Supply, is canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
