SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER Decision No. 79845, dated March 21, 1972, ordered, among other things, that automatic gate protection be provided at The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway's Crossing 2-985.8, Rose Avenue, with installation date June 30, 1974, and Crossing 2-979.6, Clovis Avenue, with installation date June 30, 1975, both in Fresno County. The county, by a letter dated June 29, 1973, has requested that the installation dates of these two crossings be exchanged. The county alleges that automobile traffic has increased on Clovis Avenue and that Clovis Avenue rated higher than Rose Avenue on a just completed railroad crossing survey. The railway does not object to the exchange. The Commission finds that the exchange of installation dates will not be adverse to the public interest. IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 79845 be amended as follows: Crossing No. Street Name Installation Date 2-979.6 Clovis Avenue 6-30-74 2-985.8 Rose Avenue 6-30-75 - 1 -
