ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Liberty Warehouse, a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Dixon and vicinity.

Liberty Warehouse has not filed with the Commission annual reports for the years 1968 through 1972. Moreover, John Waddell & Co., Certified Public Accountants, has returned the 1972 annual report forms stating by letter that the warehouse at this location is not operating on a public basis and is presently owned by Ernest and Herman Gnos.

Liberty Warehouse not having filed the annual reports as required by Section 584 of the Public Utilities Code and apparently no longer operating as a public utility warehouseman, the Commission finds that such circumstances constitute good cause for revocation of the prescriptive operative right and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the services thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Liberty Warehouse, a corporation, as determined by the Commission's order dated August 16, 1960, in Case No. 6850, is hereby revoked.

2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of Liberty Warehouse, a corporation, from California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 38, Cal.P.U.C. No. 203, on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within 90 days after the effective date of this order and on not less than 10 days' notice to the Commission and to the public.


The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Liberty Warehouse, a corporation, or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof unless, before such effective date, there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
