ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 80692 dated October 31, 1972, as amended by Decision No. 81150 dated March 13, 1973, in this proceeding, Bellair Expediting Service, Inc., a corporation, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a freight forwarder between various points in California.

Bellair Expediting Service, Inc., has informed the Commission by letter that, due to a misunderstanding concerning the requirements of said decisions regarding the establishment of the authorized service and the filing of tariffs, it was unable to meet the deadline of July 11, 1973, set forth in the aforementioned decisions for complying with such requirements. Applicant requests an extension of time permitting it to establish the service and file the necessary tariffs.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's request is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the requested extension of time should be granted.
