SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 81799 entered today in Case No. 5437 (Order Setting Hearing No. 226), the Commission established Minimum Rate Tariff 20, and Northern California Production Area and Delivery Zone Directory 2, to govern transportation of rock, sand, and gravel in four-and-five-axle dump truck equipment in the San Francisco Bay Area. The decision also provided that Minimum Rate Tariff 7 should be amended by separate order to the extent necessary to exclude traffic subject to the new tariff.

IT IS ORDERED that Minimum Rate Tariff 7 (Appendix A of Decision No. 32566, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective October 1, 1973, the revised

In all other respects, Decision No. 32566, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
