SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Ordering paragraph 5 of Decision No. 72199, dated March 28, 1967, provides that Jackson Water Works shall not extend its service area until it has obtained specific Commission authorization to do so. This portion of the order was based upon a finding that expansion would jeopardize service quality unless staff recommended plant improvements were constructed.

By this petition, applicant has reported that it has completed recommended plant improvements and, in addition, has provided other improvements not contemplated by the decision. A member of the Commission's engineering staff has verified by field investigation, that applicant has constructed the recommended improvements.

The Commission finds that a public hearing is not necessary and that the restriction in ordering paragraph 5, limiting the applicant to its present service area, is no longer necessary and concludes that such restriction should be lifted. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the restriction against service area expansion imposed by ordering paragraph 5 of Decision No. 72199 is hereby rescinded.
