## ORDER OF DISMISSAI

Appiicant held a Class A charter-party camper certipicate which expired on Febriary 18, 2970. A request to extend the authority was filed on February 25, 1972. The rile does not indicate what aisposition was made elthough the next entry shows applicant's suthority was revoked by Commssion Resolution No. PE-168 dated September 19, 1072 after it appeared that applicant had not been operating for months and when letters and notices mailed to appilcant were not answered.

The commission recentiy recelved a letter dated May 9, 2973 from appiicant's president and appanent owner which advised none of the comission notices were received because he was out of the State of Colifornia IIving in Kansas and Texas. He advised he is now invine in Invermore, Ceinfornia, and requested that applicant's former operating authority be either reinstated or reissued. Protests were recelved and the matter was to be scheduled for hearing in Augist; but letters mailed to all of the applicant's present ane past aderesses in Cainforna were retumed by the post office with the notation "Moved, not forwardable."

Applicant has ialied to provide a telephone muber and a current California mailing and buriness address. We therefore find ard conciude that the application should be dismissed.
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IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 54032 is dismissed. The Secretary of the Commission is directed to mail a copy of things order to every address listed in appiacant's file, including out-or-state locations.
