ORDER OF REVOCATION

Decision No. 80499 dated September 19, 1972 in this proceeding granted to PVO International Inc. (PVO) a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate 7,500 square feet of public utility warehouse floor space at Richmond for the storage of crude coconut oil in bulk. Acceptance of the certificate was made on October 10, 1972.

By letter dated June 29, 1973, the assistant secretary of PVO informed the Commission that it has not operated under the authority granted by Decision No. 80499 and requested that the authority be rescinded and that permission be granted not to file an annual report for the period in which the authority was operative.

The Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require the operations authorized to be conducted by Decision No. 80499 and concludes that the operative right should be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in Decision No. 80499 in Application No. 53473 is revoked.
2. Warehouse Tariff No. 1 Cal. P.U.C. No. 2 filed by PVO International Inc. is canceled.

3. FVO International Inc. is not required to file annual or other reports for the period the operative authority granted in Decision No. 80499 was in effect.
