ORDER EXTENDING PERIOD OF SUSPENSION

By an Order of Suspension and Investigation issued May 30, 1973 certain tariff sheets, filed under Advice Letter No. 19 by Salinas Valley Radio Telephone Company, were suspended until September 28, 1973 pending public hearing and further order of the Commission; and it appearing that conclusion of the matter may not be accomplished by September 28, 1973;

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the operation and effectiveness of the tariff sheets filed by respondent's Advice Letter No. 19 are hereby suspended, as provided by statute, for an additional period of six months to and including February 28, 1974, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served forthwith on Salinas Valley Radio Telephone Company, and to send a copy to Mobile Radio System of San Jose, Inc.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
