O P I N I O N

This is an application in which Adelard La Voie and Germaine La Voie, doing business as Rivera Limousine (Rivera) seek authority to sell and transfer their Class A charter-party carrier of passengers certificate to Curt N. Bosworth, doing business as Star-Dust Charters (Star-Dust).

The Commission makes the following findings and conclusion in this proceeding.

Findings of Fact

1. A public hearing is not necessary in this matter.
2. Star-Dust has approximately 10 years of experience in the transportation of passengers by motor vehicle over the public highways.
3. Star-Dust has the ability, including financial ability, to conduct operations under the certificate for which authority to transfer is sought herein.
4. Transfer of Rivera's Class A charter-party carrier of passengers certificate to Star-Dust would not be adverse to the public interest.

Conclusion of Law

The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date of this order Adelard La Voie and Germaine La Voie may sell and transfer their Class A charter-party carrier of passengers certificate (TCP-57) to Curt N. Bosworth in accordance with the agreement attached to the application.

2. Buyer shall notify the Commission, in writing, when the sale and transfer authorized herein has been consummated, within ten days thereafter.

3. Buyer is placed on notice that he will be required, among other things, to comply with the rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 98-Series and the insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order No. 101-Series, as made applicable by Section 5391 of the Public Utilities Code.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
