ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

On August 21, 1973 American Mobile Radio, Inc., an RTU under this Commission's jurisdiction, filed a petition to intervene and become a party to Case No. 9373.

American alleges that if defendants are allowed to consummate their proposed changes in facilities and if defendants are allowed to continue their "pseudo common carrier" operations American will be injured in its two-way mobile and one-way paging systems in its service area.

It appears that intervention should be granted in accordance with Rule 53 of this Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that American Mobile Radio, Inc. is an intervener in Case No. 9373 and a party to the proceeding equal to all other parties.
