ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 80765

The Commission having by Decision No. 80247 ordered the installation of interconnection devices by The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company (Pacific) to connect all except test units of Phonemaster 1040 to Pacific's telephone network and to charge therefor, and Phonetele, Inc., having been granted a Writ of Review by the California Supreme Court of said decision and the Commission having by Decision No. 80765 ordered the stay of ordering paragraphs 1, 2, 3 and 5 of Decision No. 80247, and it having come to the attention of the Commission that, based on the fact that paragraph 4 of Decision No. 80247 was not stayed, Pacific has attempted to charge for installation of its interconnection device;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Commission Decision No. 80765 is hereby amended to provide that ordering paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Decision No. 80247 are hereby stayed until further order of the Commission.
