O P I N I O N

Richard Kurwitz seeks authority to control B. L. and E. Co., which is a California corporation operating a public utility water system at Big Lagoon Park Subdivision, Humboldt County, California.

The change in control would be accomplished by the transfer of all the outstanding capital stock of B. L. and E. Co. from Georgia-Pacific Corporation to Richard Kurwitz for the purchase price of \$4,300. Said stock consists of 4,300 shares having a par value of \$1 per share.

According to the verified application, Richard Kurwitz is an independent real estate investor and logging contractor residing in said Big Lagoon Park Subdivision, and he is completely familiar with the existing water system.





After consideration the Commission finds that control of B. L. and E. Co. by Richard Kurwitz would not be adverse to the public interest, and concludes that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary. The action taken herein shall not be construed as a finding of value of the capital stock of B. L. and E. Co.

become effective when B. L. and E. Co. has filed with  
the Commission a written report relating to its standby  
source of water supply, which report is required by  
Ordering Paragraph No. 6 of Decision No. 67298, dated  
June 3, 1964, in Application No. 44736.
