ORDER GRANTING REQUESTS FOR MODIFICATION  
OF ORDERING PARAGRAPH 4 OF DECISION NO. 81621

At the hearing in this proceeding held before Examiner Cline in San Francisco on September 19, 1973, requests were made on behalf of John Webster, William Graham, and Raymond G. Haver and Elaine G. Haver, his wife, for this Commission to authorize James J. Downey, doing business as Penngrove Water Company, to accept applications to provide water service to the residences of said parties located within the service area of Penngrove Water Company.

There were no protests to the granting of such requests, and the requests were taken under submission on September 19, 1973.

The Commission finds:

1. The following residences being constructed in the service area of James J. Downey, doing business as Penngrove Water Company, will be completed within a few days after September 19, 1973, and the owners of such residences require water service from Penngrove Water Company so that the residences may be occupied by the owners and their families:

- (a) Residence of John Webster located at 835 Palm Avenue, Penngrove, California.
- (b) Residence of William Graham located at 10355 Old Redwood Highway North, Cotati, California.
- (c) Residence of Raymond G. Haver and Elaine G. Haver, his wife, located at 839 Palm Avenue, Penngrove, California.

2. James J. Downey, doing business as Penngrove Water Company, is ready, willing, and able to furnish water service to the applicants whose residences are listed in Finding 1 above without detrimental effect to the service to the other existing customers of Penngrove Water Company.

The Commission concludes that Ordering Paragraph 4 of Decision No. 81621 in Case No. 9076 should be modified to permit James J. Downey, doing business as Penngrove Water Company, to provide

water service to the applicants whose residences are listed in Finding 1 above.

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 4 of Decision No. 81621 dated July 24, 1973 in Case No. 9076 is modified to provide that James J. Downey, doing business as Penngrove Water Company, may accept applications for water service from and provide water service to the residences of the following applicants:

- (a) John Webster whose residence is located at 835 Palm Avenue, Penngrove, California.
- (b) William Graham whose residence is located at 10355 Old Redwood Highway North, Cotati, California.
- (c) Raymond G. Haver and Elaine G. Haver, his wife, whose residence is located at 839 Palm Avenue, Penngrove, California.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
