## INTERIM OPINTON AND ORDER

On May 30, 1973 an "Order of Suspension and Investigation" was entered which ordered an investigation into the reasonableness of C. W. Bird, dba Anoosh-Van Water System's tariff Sheets Nos. 125-W and $126-\mathrm{W}$ which were filed on May 10, 1973 under Advice Letter No. 9. The "Order of Suspension and Investigation" also ordered the suspension of said cariff filings for a pexiod of ninety days.
